

7th-8th Grade Summer Reading Assignment

**Read TWO books of your choice this summer. Complete a “One-Pager” for EACH book.
Due on the FIRST day of school for your first Language Arts grade.**

A One-Pager is a way to visually share key ideas and information from what you have learned. When you create a One-Pager, you are trying to use both visual symbols and important words to clearly and concisely share your most important takeaways with someone else.

On the second page of this Doc, a template is provided. You can print two (2) copies out and use them to complete your summer assignment. On the third page, there are examples to review.

Here is what EACH “One-Pager” MUST INCLUDE:

- ★ Middle box - Title of novel
- ★ A border that somehow represents the key themes from your novel (If you do not know or understand what a THEME is, please research this!)
- ★ An image in the upper left-hand box with a quotation woven into or around it. This image should somehow represent what you consider to be the most important symbol in the text so far.
- ★ Images or words in the upper right-hand box that represent the key characters from the text.
- ★ Images in the lower left-hand box that show at least one major setting from your novel in some way.
- ★ Images and/or words in the bottom right-hand box that show connections between the themes in the novel and what is going on in the world today (text-to-world).
- ★ Anywhere on page: Three important quotes from the text.
- ★ Remember - quotes must be in quotation marks - not simply things the narrator states.

You may also add other symbols, drawings, and words that represent the reading as you wish anywhere on the page.




